SAFETY OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not exceed the products rated maximum load capacity.
- Always distribute objects evenly on the Mobile Parts Bin Trolley. Uneven weight distribution could cause tipping.
- Do not lean or climb onto the Mobile Parts Bin Trolley.
- Only use this device for the purpose for which it has been designed.
- Do not modify any component of this equipment.
- When servicing, use only Tradequip identical replacement parts. Use of any other parts will void the warranty.
- Only use on a flat surface capable of supporting the Mobile Parts Bin Trolley and its rated maximum capacity load. It is easy to lose control of the Mobile Parts Bin Trolley if attempting to pull a load on a sloping or uneven surface.
- Use the right product for the job. There are certain applications for which the Mobile Parts Bin Trolley was designed. Do not modify the Mobile Parts Bin Trolley and do not use the Mobile Parts Bin Trolley for a purpose for which it was not intended.

ASSEMBLY, OPERATION, PREVENTITIVE MAINTENANCE

1. FEATURES


The Tradequip Mobile Parts Bin Storage Systems keep the tools and parts you need for the job organised and easily accessible in its convenient mobile design. With assorted small and large storage bins, this portable floor rack helps organize and store countless parts. Features include four smooth rolling swivel castors for easy manoeuvrability around your work area and a glossy powder coat finish for durability. Powder coated steel racks with robust composite storage bins evenly spread across multiple shelves. Mounted on heavy-duty castors (two lockable) for mobility. unit can hold up to a maximum weight of 60kg - 150kg (Model dependant) evenly spread across the bins. A great mobile tool storage for any garage or workshop, this piece of kit is widely used for collecting and storing parts and/or tools when servicing vehicles and machinery etc.


2. ASSEMBLY


Unpacking: after removing the packing material, make sure the product is in perfect condition and that there are no visible damaged parts. The packaging materials (Polyethylene bags, polystyrene etc.), should be disposed of responsibly in an appropriate refuse collection container. These materials must not be left within the reach of children as they are potential sources of danger.


Assemble the Trolley:

- 1. Take the four uprights and insert the four castors into the bottom of each. (See fig.1) Ensure the castors are fully seated.
- 2. Assemble the front and back frames.
- Take two of the uprights with locking castors and insert long beam between the two uprights at the top and bottom. (See fig.2) Ensure the beams are the correct way up (See fig.2A/B) and seated correctly, use a soft faced mallet to tap the beams home.
- 4. Repeat process for the other two uprights using the non-locking castors.
- 5. Attach the front and rear frame together using the smaller side braces with the double tabs, insert at the top and bottom of the frames (See fig.3A). Ensure again they are the correct way up and that the locking castors are at the front.
- 6. Between the two uprights, install the centre braces (single tab) half way up the frames. see fig.3B.
- 7. **6054 only** As well as the side braces attach front and rear beam (single tab) exactly half way up the frame, front and back (See fig.3B).
- 8. Insert the remaining cross beams in the frame using fig.4 and fig.5 to space them out correctly. Ensure the beams are the correct way around to hold the wire shelves (See fig.4, fig.5). As before use a soft faced mallet to tap the beams into place.
- Starting at the bottom place the wire shelves into the frame ensuring the shelves for the larger bins are at the bottom and the shelves for the smaller bins are at the top.
- 10. Place the flat wire shelf on the top. the storage system is now ready to use.





3. BEFORE USE

Prior to each use conduct a visual inspection by checking for abnormal conditions, such as cracked joints and damaged, loose, or missing parts.

4. STORAGE

This Mobile Parts Bin Storage System should always be stored in a dry location on a level surface.

5. MAINTENANCE

Inspect the general condition of the Mobile Parts Bin Storage System checking:

- for loose hardware
- misalignment of binding or parts, cracked, bent, or broken parts, and
- any other condition that may affect the safe operation.
- Clean the Mobile Parts Bin Storage System after each use. Ensure dirt, oil, grease and debris are cleaned off after each use.

6. SERVICE & REPAIR

Any Mobile Parts Bin Storage System found damaged in any way, or found to be worn or operates abnormally should be removed from service until repaired by an authorised service agent. Owners and / or operators should be aware that repair of this product may require specialised equipment and knowledge. Only authorised parts, labels, decals shall be used on this equipment. Annual inspection is recommended and can be made by an authorised repair facility to ensure that your equipment is in optimum condition and that the equipment has the correct decals and safety labels specified by the manufacturer.
