

WHAT IT IS

Wash-A-Way is the ideal cleaner for anyone wishing to avoid using chlorine bleach. It is a safe and effective alkaline salt-based cleaner and soaker, with an oxidising, mild bleach action. The active ingredients are alkaline salts (>62%) and sodium percarbonate (>30%).

WHAT IT IS USED FOR

Wash-A-Way is ideal for cleaning for external grimy, mouldy and weathered timbers and masonry as well as being safe for use on stained plastic, china and metal surfaces such as stained tea/coffee pots. It can also be used as an extra-strength laundry soaker, and has anti-bacterial properties.

HOW TO APPLY

- Wet the timber being cleaned as well as its surrounds with fresh cold water.
- Dissolve ½ 1 cup of Wash-A-Way powder in a bucket containing 10 litres of hot water (50-70° C).
- Apply the Wash-A-Way solution to the timber's surface, and scrub with a stiff bristle brush or broom. Leave for 30-45 minutes.
- (For external use)
- Rinse off with fresh water or pressure cleaner if timber is very dirty and/or stained.
- Allow to dry for a minimum of 48 hours in good drying conditions, before evaluating the timber's condition. If necessary, repeat the procedure if stains or mould are still evident.
- Once completely clean and dry, apply a timber finishing oil such as Organoil Decking and Exterior Oil.

COVERAGE

10 litres of solution should clean approximately 9-12 square metres.

SIZE

Wash-A-Way concentrate powder is available in 1kg containers which makes up to 70 litres of solution.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

- Keep out of waterways and ponds.
- Wash-A-Way may give off dangerous gas if mixed with other chemicals.
- Strongly alkaline. May cause severe burns if in contact with the skin. Wear gloves and other protective clothing.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- Avoid splashing concentrate or solution into the eyes. Wear eye protection.
- DO NOT SWALLOW. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Contact a medical professional immediately.
- For splashes on the skin or hair, remove any contaminated clothing, then flush skin or hair with fresh cold water for at least 15 minutes. For splashes in the eye, hold eye open and flush with fresh cold water for 15 minutes. Contact a health professional.

When used as directed, Wash-A-Way will not kill plants or grass, however, temporary browning of the foliage may occur. If you are concerned, hose off foliage with fresh water.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

If your timber has been grey and weathered for many years, this cleaning procedure may not be effective, and the only way to fully rejuvenate your timber may be by sanding, or replacement.
